### **Maintenance and storage**

After every brew you should wipe off the frame and stainless steel top with a warm soft non-abrasive rag to remove any spills or boil over residue.

## **Pumps**

Make sure to always run your pump with water or some liquid in it. Never run your pump while it is dry! The motor should be oiled at least once every six months with 4-5 drops of SAE 20-weight non-detergent oil in each bearing.

#### **Burners**

Make sure all the jets on the burners are free from any water, wort or brewing residue prior from being lit. Debris in the jet cavity will not allow that jet to light which will reduce its efficiency. The burners will produce a light carbon buildup on the bottom of the kettles. This is normal.

Use a licensed HVAC contractor to install the proper pipe size and to make sure there is proper gas pressure coming into the system.

Natural gas = 7" water column

Propane = 11.5" water column

# WARNING: Major damage to the system will occur if you exceed these pressures.

# **Control panel**

- 1. Clean the control panel with a soft damp rag.
- 2. NEVER open the control panel cover while plugged in.
- 3. The control panel and all the switches are not water proof. If liquid is spilled on the control panel, unplug it and wipe it off immediately.

#### Chiller

Clean chiller as per manufacturer specs provided with your Blichmann chiller.
